Chau Do serves as the Deputy Comptroller for the Risk Analysis Division (RAD) within Supervision Risk & Analysis at the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency (OCC).

In this capacity, Dr. Do oversees the four RAD divisions in the agency's that provide expertise to the agency on quantitative modeling of commercial credit risk, retail credit risk, market risk, and compliance risk.
